## Project presentation

«eCAMPUS» is an Erasmus+ CBHE Strand-3 project funded by the European Union, aimed at supporting a national and structural reform in Armenian Higher Education Institutions (HEIs), with a focus on the quality of digital teaching, learning and assessment (TLA).

The project addresses key priorities such as the development of teaching staff digital competences, the implementation of internal quality assurance (QA) systems for digital TLA, the establishment of effective digital learning ecosystems and infrastructures, the adoption of innovative pedagogical practices, and the development of supportive regulatory frameworks

## Background and goal for the visit

The 2-day study visit is organised within Work Package 4 (SMARTclass), which focuses on developing framework standards for e-learning multimedia platforms and smart classroom models for Armenian HEIs.

Hosted by the University of Genoa (UniGe), the visit is designed as an experiential learning activity aimed at advancing participants' understanding of technology-enhanced (TE) teaching, learning and assessment (TLA).

The programme offers opportunities to observe digital platforms, infrastructures and smart learning environments in use at UniGe, engage with instructional technologies and multimedia systems, explore their integration into institutional and pedagogical practices, and discuss their impact on student engagement, collaborative learning and assessment.

The study visit includes guided sessions across different UniGe facilities, such as the e-learning and multimedia services, the Teaching and Learning Centre (UTLC), and technology-enhanced learning environments.

By experiencing these practices in their real operational context, participants will gain insights into how technology can support inclusive, high-quality digital education and how such approaches can be adapted to the Armenian higher education context.

## Work package objectives

The SMARTclass work package aims to develop benchmark standards for e-learning multimedia platforms and smart classroom models in Armenian HEIs, with the goal of: promoting effective and inclusive learning environments; supporting technology-enhanced instructional models; and ensuring equitable access to digital learning resources and tools. The study visit is therefore conceived not as a reporting activity, but as an opportunity to observe, experience and critically reflect on real implementations of technology-enhanced education.
